



Classroom Jeopardy!

Classroom Jeopardy! is our fun take on the classic television game show.

Setup:

Download the appropriate files. You'll need the Powerpoint file and the script. Open the file and run the show. You may wish to use several bells for players to signal. Divide students into appropriate teams, decide which team picks the first question.

Playing the game:

1. A team chooses a category and value. Click on the category and value.
2. Read the clue from the script.
3. Read the clue and allow the students actively playing to try to provide the answer. (You can use a bell or have the student raise their hand to see who gets to answer the question)
5. If the correct answer is given, click on the clue to reveal the answer and proceed back to the game board. If the wrong answer is given, allow other students an opportunity to provide the correct answer.
6. Keep track of points earned by teams on the whiteboard or a separate sheet of paper. (You might have a student do this job)

***Modifications**

- Require all students to answer in the form of a question.
- Deduct points if an incorrect answer is provided by a team.
